#### Who can participate?

o Entry will be required to include full name, email address, zip code and phone number for contact purposes.

o Participants will also have the option to upload illustrations, pictures, or any other visual medium to help express their story and bring the narrative to life.

#### **Contest Timeline**

Contest will run from March 1 - April 15, 2022. Winners will be announced on May 1, 2022.

#### How will a winner be chosen?

By a panel of 3 judges. Entries will be judged on three categories to include Story Telling, Community Integration, Park Characters Integration. These categories will be equally weighted.

#### What are the prizes?

1st Place Winner: Will receive their story published at the Park, Delaware County District Library and as an e-book version of their story. There will also be a \$100 cash prize.

2nd Place: Will receive an e-book version of their story and a \$50 Beanbag Books gift card.

3rd Place: Will receive an e-book version of their story.
